**A one day felting workshop with
times of stillness, quiet and
simple meditation**

About the Day

The day will be a mixture of quiet spaces and creative wet-felting activities using coloured Merino wool and other fibres. You will be able to work at your own pace but with ideas, teaching and support provided.

The day will begin and end with a short meditation and time of quiet and you are welcome to join with the brothers for their lunchtime worship if you so wish. There will also be brief periods of silence throughout the day – for a few minutes each hour. Quite surprisingly, these small silences bring a powerful and extra dimension of stillness and spirituality to our day and to our creativity.

During the day you will make a small sample piece of flat felt, from wool and other fibres which are added for texture. So, if you're not familiar with wet felting, you will learn about the simple but exciting processes involved. This small piece can then be turned into your own unique needle case if you wish.

After this you will use your own ideas and choices of coloured wool and fibres to create a larger piece of wet felt which can be made into your own felted notebook cover. This will be a removable cover so you can use it again and again with new notebooks. You may hand stitch this as well if you want to add further decoration, or use Anne's sewing machine to stitch it or not stitch it at all!
