About the Day

Without a brightly coloured jacket, and with the Bible as my guide book rather than Bradshaw, today I will guide you on some of the Great Faith Journeys of the World: from Exodus to Emmaus; from Wise Men to Walsingham; from Paul's mission to Pilgrimage.

Programme

9.45am Arrivals and refreshments

10.00am Session 1. Let my people go! (Exodus 5:1 etc.). The Old Testament - Journeys of Escape.
A look at some of journeys of the Old Testament, including Abraham, Noah & Elijah, and of course the Exodus itself.

11.00am Refreshment break

11.15am Session 2. 'It is impossible for a prophet to be killed outside of Jerusalem.' (Luke 13:33) The Gospels - Journey to Jerusalem.
Most of the key events in John's Gospel take place in Jerusalem, while Luke's Gospel has been described as a Journey to Jerusalem. We look at the journeys of the Gospel, from the birth to the crucifixion of Jesus.

12.10pm Eucharist with the Community of the Resurrection *(optional)*

1.00pm Lunch

1.45pm Session 3. 'Go and make disciples of all nations.' (Matt. 28:19). The New Testament - Journeys to the World.
A look at the early years of the Christian Church and the beginnings of its mission as the Gospel is taken out from its foundation into the known world.

2.45pm Session 4. 'Come, see the place...' (Matt. 28:4). Pilgrimage - Journeys we can make. Most faiths at least encourage journeys to key places in their history. We can visit the land where Jesus lived, or the Shrines of the Saints, but Pilgrimage need not be arduous or expensive and I will also try to show how pilgrimages can be made much closer to home.
