#### About the course leader:

Robert Dawson ("Bob) became involved with Romanies and other Travellers at the age of 11 and 63 years later is still.

Though not of Traveller origin himself, he is Hon President of Britain's largest Gypsy Traveller (GT) organisation and an Honorable member and adviser to several more. He has campaigned all his life to improve the lot and understanding of GTs.

He has written over 80 books and specialist papers and was instrumental in bringing in culture specific books for Traveller children into schools. He has discovered and mapped lost GT wayside burials, researched child mortality, highlighted the hardly known British Gypsy slavery, recorded samples of language of Romani, Pavee Cant and Nawken Cant and numerous folk tales as well as locating and publishing photos of the little known Holocaust of Europe's Gypsy population by the Nazis. He is currently working on a book to prove, once and for all, the massive extent and reasons for this genocide.

A few years ago, the GT Community presented him with a Lifetime Award for all his voluntary work with the community.


