

# **Travel directions to the Community & College of the Resurrection**

**WF14 0BN**

## **By Car**

From the M62 – Come off at junction 25. Follow the signs towards Mirfield. There is often a queue of traffic at Cooper Bridge Roundabout. Fork left and follow the signs towards **Leeds**. Go past the Miller & Carter Steakhouse on the left and the garage / Metro Inn on the right and turn right at the next traffic lights onto Stocksbank Road (signed to Battyeford and CR House). The retreat house entrance gate is about half a mile down this road on the right at the top of the hill on Stocksbank Road, opposite Kitson Hill Road. The College entrance gate is further down the hill. The middle gate is kept locked.

From the M1 – Come off at Junction 40 signed Dewsbury. Take the A638 to Dewsbury then follow the signs for Huddersfield (A644) until you get to Mirfield. Go through Mirfield, past the shops until you reach the 40mph zone. Continue along the road until you see a sign to Battyeford. Turn right here (almost opposite the Velvet Lounge restaurant) into Stocksbank Road. Drive up the hill, passing the Airedale Heifer pub, the phone box and bus stop (all on the left). Almost immediately after the bus stop is the College entrance gate. For the Retreat House, continue further up the hill to the top gate, almost opposite Kitson Hill Road.

## **By Train or Bus**

Grand Central trains from London stop at Mirfield. There are trains from Manchester Airport to Mirfield with a variable number of changes. The journey time is about an hour. For other train services there are connecting trains from Bradford, Leeds, Wakefield Westgate or Huddersfield that stop at Mirfield. It is also possible to get local buses from Leeds and Huddersfield.

There are taxi ranks on the South side of the platform and on the right-hand-side of the road leading into the centre of Mirfield. Telephone 'Station Cars' 01924 490490.

To walk from Mirfield station, walk up Station Road past Lidl supermarket towards the traffic lights on the main road. Turn left and walk approximately 1 mile to Stocksbank road which branches off to the right. Continue uphill until you reach the College

entrance on your left. A few hundred yards further on, on the left, is the Retreat House entrance.

Alternatively, 202 and 203 buses stop in Mirfield town centre (walk up past Lidl supermarket towards the traffic lights and turn left). Ask for 'House of the Resurrection' on Stockbank Road. The journey takes 5 minutes.
